The NAoMe Scoping Document was published on 30th November 2023 and includes:

- a review of key metastatic breast cancer clinical guidelines & relevant literature,
- results from the Scoping Survey carried out from February to April 2023,
- a summary of key findings from the National Audit of Breast Cancer in Older Patients (NABCOP), and
- a review of NABCOP and external performance indicators.



This includes Cancer Recurrence data items. It is important that recurrent cancers are recorded correctly through COSD. Patients with primary breast cancer which spreads to other parts of the body at a later date will be included in the NAoMe. We are currently working hard with COSD to improve the process of recording recurrence information.
