Dear Colleague

We are all aware of the current pressures of the Covid pandemic and the increasing difficulties this is causing in providing normal care for our patients.

As per our previous statement <u>please see the ABS website</u> for the principles you might consider applying in the running of your service and the treatment of individual patients in the current surge.

Today we want to draw your attention to two things, firstly the letter from the four CMOs, and in particular paragraph 8 which states:

"We want doctors, in partnership with patients and other healthcare staff, always to use their professional judgement to assess the risks of both COVID and non-COVID harms to make sure people receive safe care, informed by the values and principles set out in their professional standards. A rational approach to varying practice in an emergency is part of that professional response" and our response to this as it applies to the NHS Breast Screening Programme as well as a letter regarding the NHS BSP, which we sent to Prof Sir Simon Stevens earlier this month.
