CancerStats2 portal

CancerStats2 is the new and updated National Cancer Registration and Analysis Service (NCRAS) information and reporting portal, for users within the NHS in England. Sections including the COSD reporting portal, information on radiotherapy and systemic anti-cancer therapy, as well as individual NHS organisation's data returns for national audits such as the NABCOP.
