

Mammary Fold Senior Representative

Role & Responsibilities

The Senior Representative on the Mammary Fold Committee is a post for trainees who have reached their final 2 years of training (this includes those in OOP). To be eligible to apply for this role, an individual needs to be a Mammary Fold member for a minimum of 6 months.

The senior representative role has two main components. Firstly, the representative acts as a liaison between senior breast trainees/consultants and the Mammary Fold Committee, feeding back any training or teaching issues for discussion at national committee meetings. Secondly, the senior representative role involves supporting and coordinating the regional representatives. The senior representative serves as the main point of contact for the regional representatives and plays a key role in the identification of any region-specific issues related to breast surgery training, encouraging regional representatives to deliver or promote educational events related to breast surgery and ensuring breast surgery trainees in each region are identified. You will be invited to attend the Mammary Fold Executive Committee meetings, with a minimum attendance requirement of 50%. If unable to attend, formal written apologies should be submitted to the Secretary of Mammary Fold. As a new role, you will also hold a position on the main ABS Aesthetics committee as the MF representative, maintaining attendance to these meetings is vital.

It is a rewarding role and is a good starting point for developing your managerial and leadership skills. We look forward to working with you.
