




Closure is in layers with strong subcutaneous key sutures around the margin of the areola (to stop stretching) and at key tension points, such as points 'A' and 'B'. Final closure technique is a matter of personal preference. At this point the reduced breast should be higher up on the chest wall and should have good volume, shape and symmetry with the reconstructed breast.
