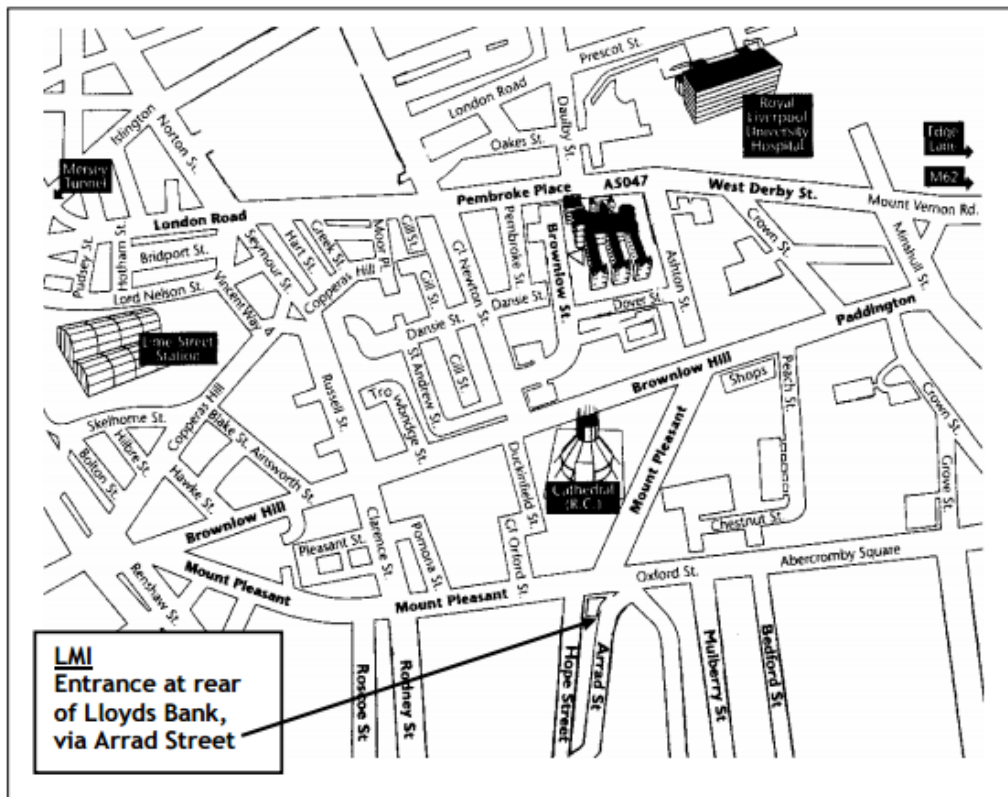

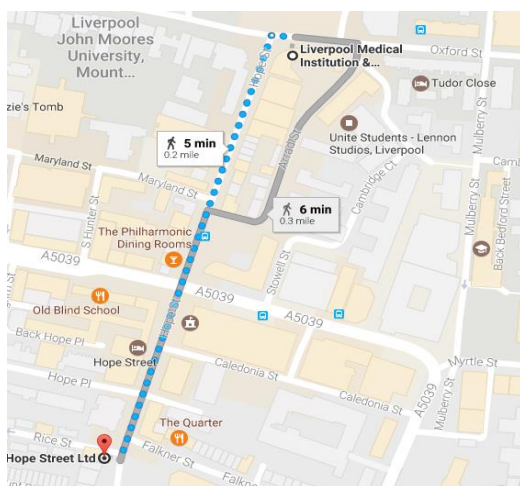
### DIRECTIONS FROM THE M62 / M6

If approaching from the end of the M62, follow signs for the City Centre, down Edge Lane, past Retail Park and GPT on the left hand. Continue to follow City Centre signs until you see brown tourist signs for Cathedrals. Follow these signs until you see sign for R.C. Cathedral with Blackwells University Book Shop on your left. Turn left, and continue past the Cathedral until the road branches off to the left. At this junction the Medical Institution is directly opposite you. The entrance is at the rear of the building immediately behind Lloyds Bank.
