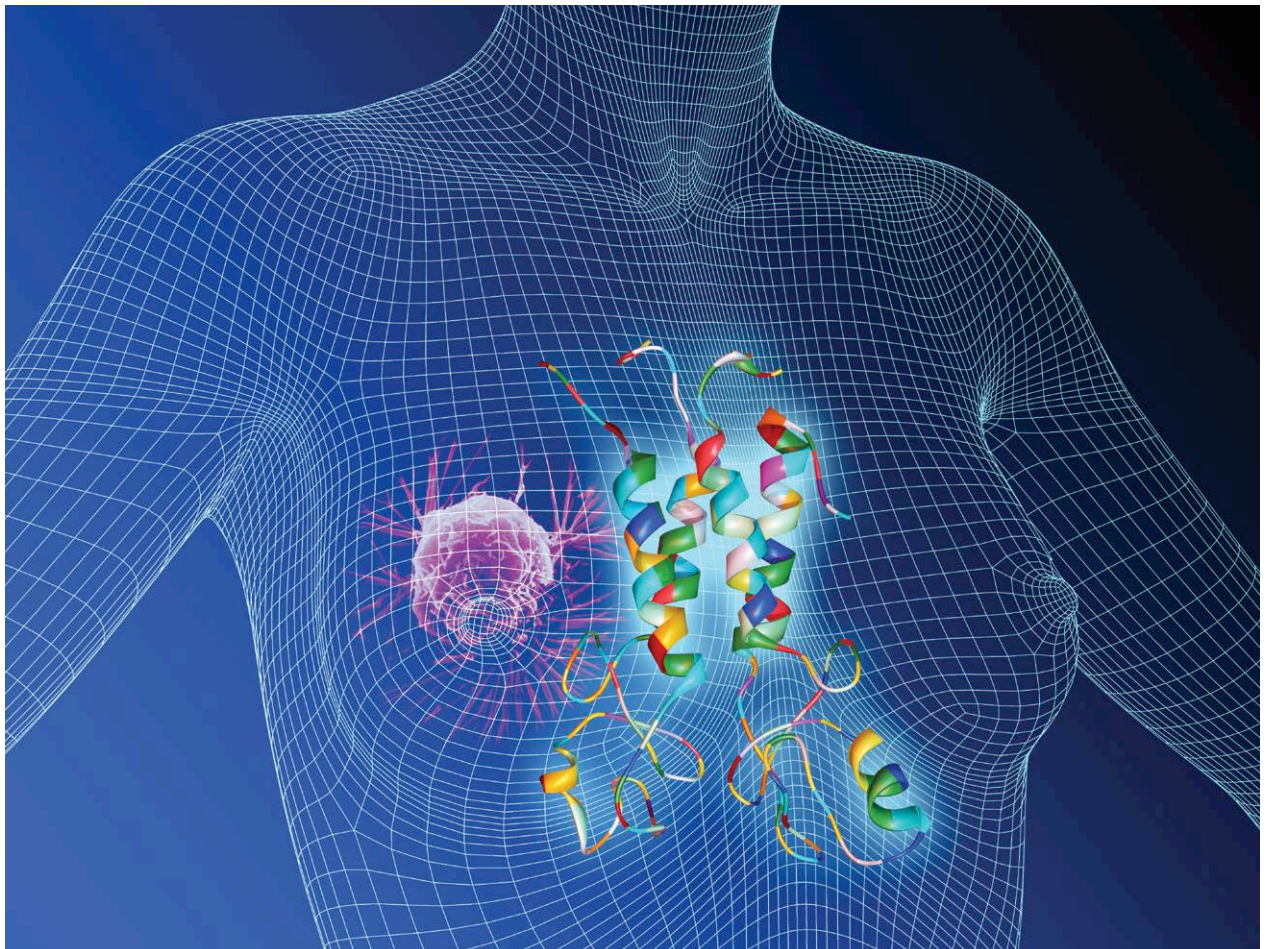

# The 11th Annual Royal Marsden Breast Cancer Meeting: Hot Topics in Breast Cancer

---

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that we are holding the 11th Annual Royal Marsden Breast Cancer Meeting on Friday 12th of October 2018 at the Royal College of Physicians, London NW1.

This year we hope to continue to provide an update on what is new, challenging and controversial in the management of patients with breast cancer. We will address the contentious dilemmas surrounding neo-adjuvant therapy in imaging, radiotherapy and surgery –what is emerging from current experience and evidence, and potentially what the future holds. We hope to reflect on oncology data from the conferences and how that translates to our practice in the clinic as well as an update on the management of lymphoedema and menopausal symptoms.

This year we are delighted to announce our Cridlan Speaker, Professor Dame Lesley Fallowfield, who will be addressing “The Art of Communication”. Professor Dame Fallowfield is the Director of the Sussex Health Outcomes Research & Education in Cancer (SHORE-C) group, University of Sussex Medical School. She became the full-time Director of a Psychosocial Oncology Group in 1991 and was awarded the first European Chair in Psycho-oncology from University College, London in 1997. Well known for her research interests far and wide to include the measurement of quality of life in clinical trials of cancer therapy and the training of communication skills for health care professionals in cancer. She is a Fellow of the UK Academy of Medical Sciences and in 2016 a Dame Commander of the Order of the British Empire in the New Year Honours. Always a thoughtful and compelling speaker, Dame Fallowfield presents approaches on better communication with our patients in the increasingly complex area of risk and outcomes from breast cancer therapy. The day is brought to a close by the ever popular MDT in which we hope will stimulate further discussion and debate.

The meeting is open to all professionals who are involved in looking after women with breast cancer, including clinicians and senior nurses. We will be holding the meeting again at the Royal College of Physicians, and it is recommended that you book your place early given that we were heavily oversubscribed last year.

We look forward to seeing you in October.
