It may be that not all sections of the form are relevant, or you are very early in your study development, but please complete with as much information as you are able, so we are best placed to provide advice.

Specific deadlines from meetings will be published in the ABS research updates (delivered by email) and on the ABS website. The Committee will let you know if your proposal has been accepted for presentation 2 weeks ahead of the meeting. Once accepted a PowerPoint presentation should be prepared for the meeting: Maximum 8 minutes, 8 slides detailing the research question, any preliminary work/data to justify the question and its importance, the proposed methodology and questions for the committee.
