Regional Representative on ABS Clinical Practice and Standards Committee Role Description

1. The Regional Representative shall attend Clinical Practice and Standards Committee meetings on behalf of the ABS members in their region and should not be absent for consecutive meetings without good cause.
2. The Regional Representative shall represent the views of members in their region at these meetings and feedback to them such information as is relevant.
3. The Regional Representative shall liaise with the Association Manager about such projects as the Trustees or the Chair of the CPS Committee wish to undertake on a regional basis.
4. The Regional Representatives shall take on other roles as determined by the Trustees or CPS Committee Chair to take forward the work of the committee and the Association.
5. The Regional Representatives shall help coordinate ABS regional meetings every two years.
6. The Regional Representatives will support the reviewing of the job descriptions for consultant breast surgery posts submitted to the RCS England for approval.
7. The Regional Representatives will support the ongoing review of guidance on the ABS information hub and the development of new guidance.
